NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The City of Buford, Georgia hereby gives public notice that it is the policy of the City of Buford to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 and related statutes regulations in all programs and activities. It is our policy that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any of our programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been subjected to unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint. The complaint must be filed in writing or in person with the City of Buford Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Office located at Buford City Hall within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of the alleged discriminatory act or upon notice of the discriminatory act. Title VI Discrimination Complaint Forms may be obtained from the EEO Office located at Buford City Hall, visiting the City's website and clicking on Online Forms on the left of the page and then scrolling to the section labeled Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) and then clicking on the Title VI Discrimination Complaint Form, or by calling (770) 945-6761.
