The Buford City Commission held public hearings on August 2, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. at Buford City Arena, 2795 Sawnee Avenue regarding the fiscal year 2022 operating budget and the proposed City of Buford tax increases for City residents in Gwinnett County and Hall County. Chairman Beard opened the hearings with comments on the FY 2022 budget, the proposed tax increases for 2021 and gave an overview of the law and the City's proposed millage rate. The Commission is proposing a millage rate of 12.60 for 2021 for both Gwinnett and Hall Counties, Hall County with the LOST rollback. The property tax increase for Gwinnett County is proposed at 0.94% over the rollback millage rate of 12.483 and the property tax increase for Hall County is proposed at 0.76% over the rollback millage rate of 12.505.
